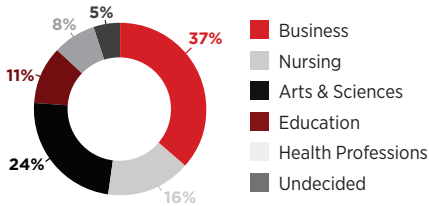

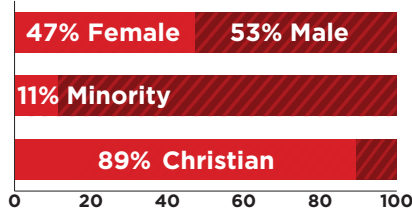

Since the merger with CUW (2013-14), CUAAs have been the fastest growing independent institution in Michigan

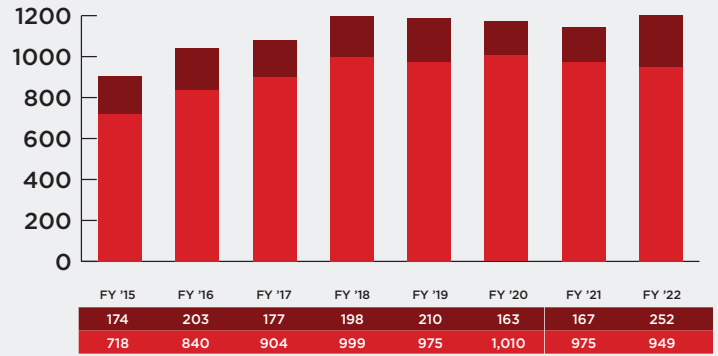


Since 2013-14, CUAAs have annually ranked among the fastest growing institutions in Michigan, public or private.

■ Graduate/Professional ■ Traditional Undergraduate

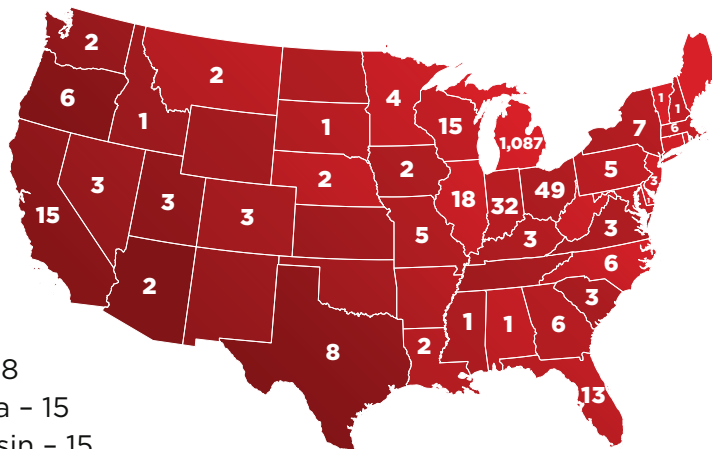

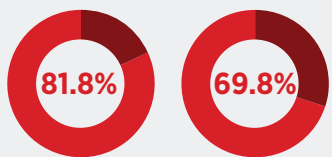

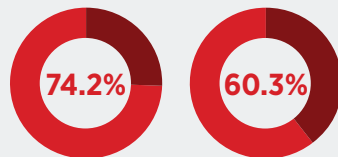
Employed 6-12 months after graduation

Employed full-time 6-12 months after graduation

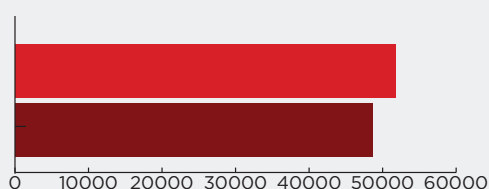

■ CUAAs ■ US small school average



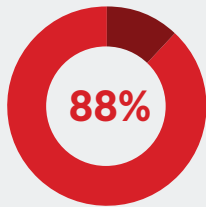
CUAAs' employment rates beat national small school averages

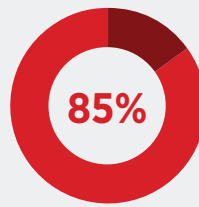
What our GRADS SAY

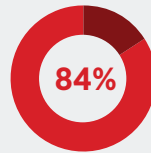
88% felt that faculty and staff personally cared about them and their growth as an individual



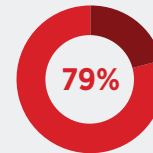
82% agreed that Concordia provided a positive environment for learning, living, and personal growth
